

Big canvas tote bag

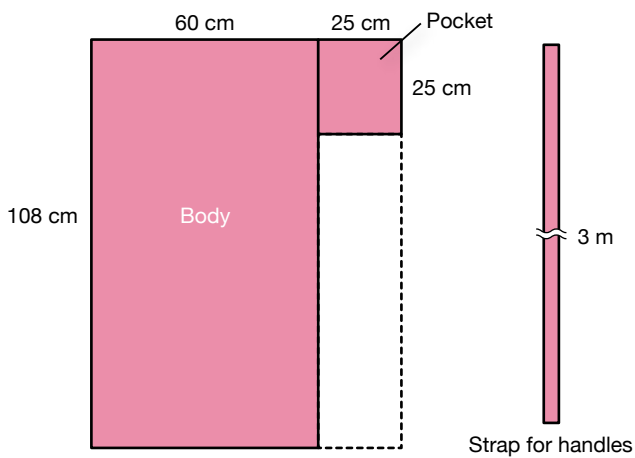
1. If there are no instructions to use a specific stitch, use the straight stitch.
2. Presser foot "J" (straight stitch/zigzag stitch) and overcasting foot "G" will be used.



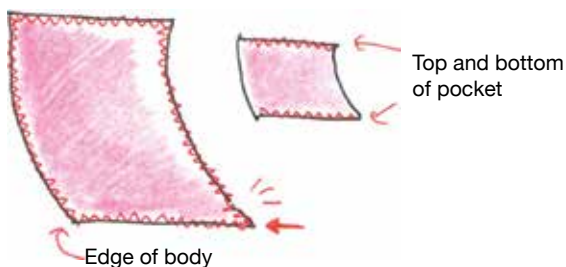
Materials

- Medium weight canvas (82 cm wide × 108 cm)
- Sequin tape (4 to 5 mm wide × 95 cm)
- Lamé tape (4 to 5 mm wide × 70 cm)
- Strap for handles (4 cm wide × 3 m)

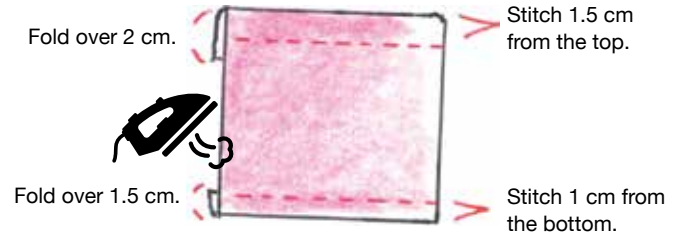
Cutting diagram



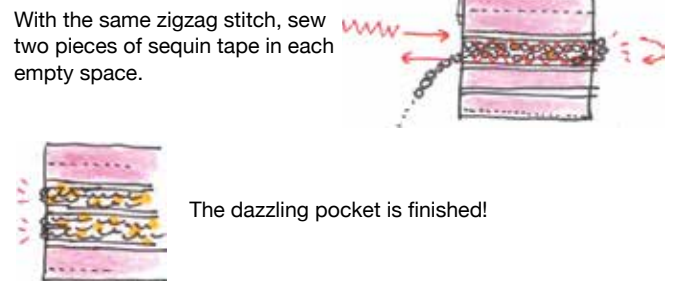
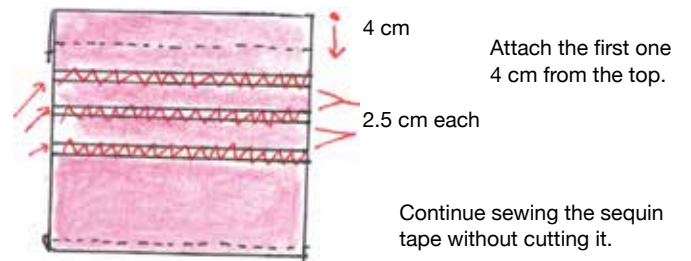
- 1 Sew overcast stitching (for heavy-weight fabrics) along the edges of the body and pocket.



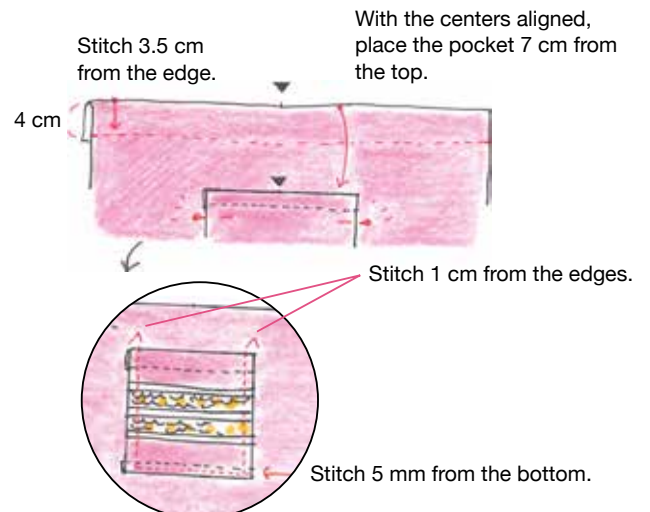
- 2 Fold over the top and bottom of the pocket and stitch.



- 3 Sew on the lamé tape with a zigzag stitch. Sew on three pieces equally spaced.

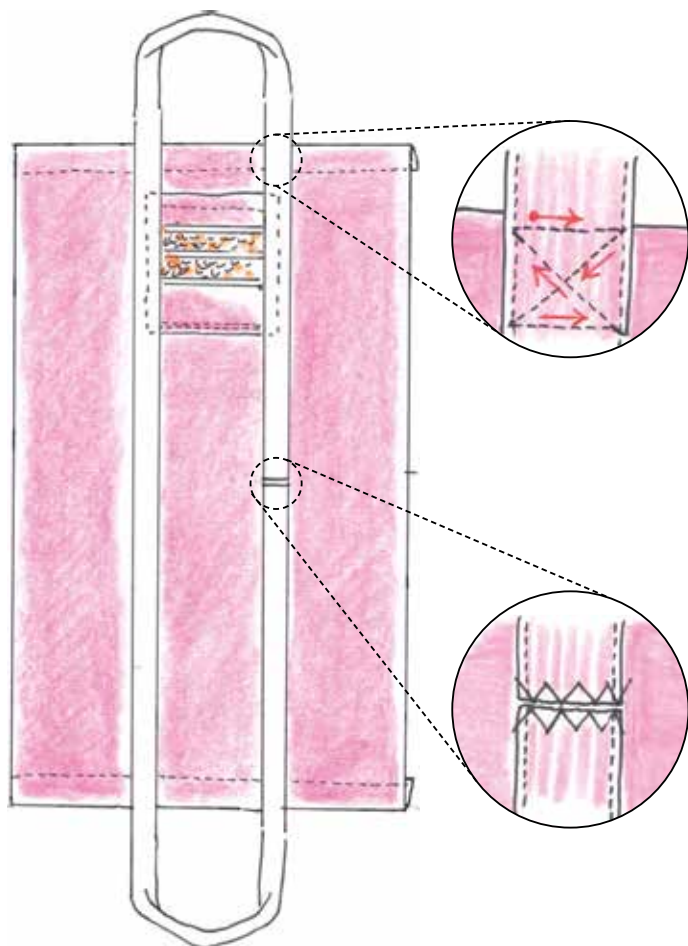


- 4 Stitch the opening of the body, and then sew on the pocket.



- 5** Place the strap for the handles over the sides of the pocket, and then stitch along the inside and outside of the strap.

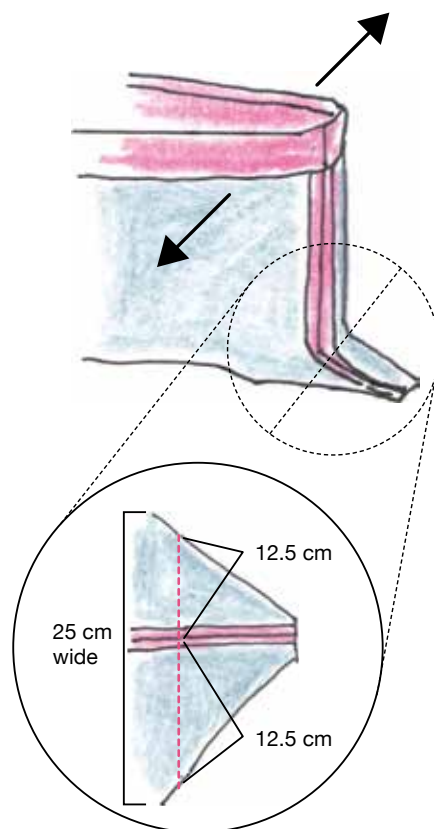
Sew X-shaped reinforcements at the openings of the body. After all other stitching is finished, sew the ends of the strap together with a zigzag stitch.



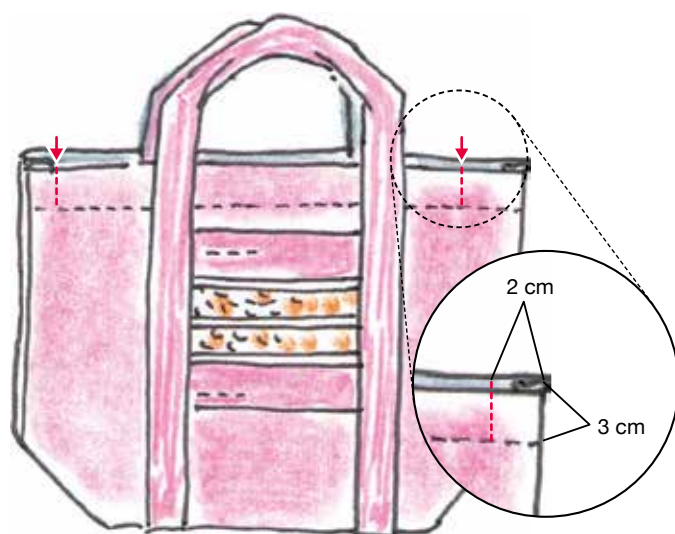
- 6** Fold in half with right sides together, and then stitch along both sides.



- 7** Stitch the gussets. Open the opening to the front and back, and then fold the bottom corner to form a triangle. Sew straight stitching perpendicular to the seam so that the stitching has a width of 25 cm.



- 8** Turn right side out, and then sew overlapping stitching at the opening to reinforce the side seams.



Sew back and forth 2 to 3 times.
