

# Slippers

1. If there are no instructions to use a specific stitch, use the straight stitch.
2. Presser foot "J" (straight stitch/zigzag stitch) will be used.



These slippers are made from thick felt. Three-dimensional items may seem difficult to make, but even beginners can complete the project if they carefully sew according to the instructions. When inserting pins into thick fabric, be careful not to poke your fingers.

Some models may not have functions used for the sample shown in the photo.

## Materials

- Fabric for upper and thick felt for sole (65 cm wide × 28 cm)
- Jersey for insole (25 cm wide × 28 cm)
- Stabilizer (25 cm wide × 28 cm)

Draw joining marks with an erasable pen.



Fabric for upper

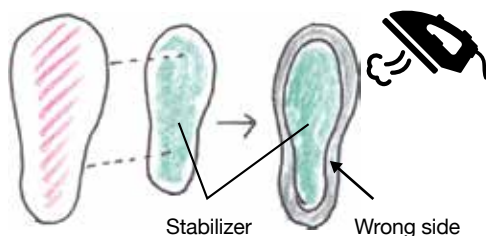
Thick felt for sole

Jersey for insole

Stabilizer  
Cut 1 cm smaller than the pattern.

Flip over the pattern, and then cut it out to make a left and a right slipper.

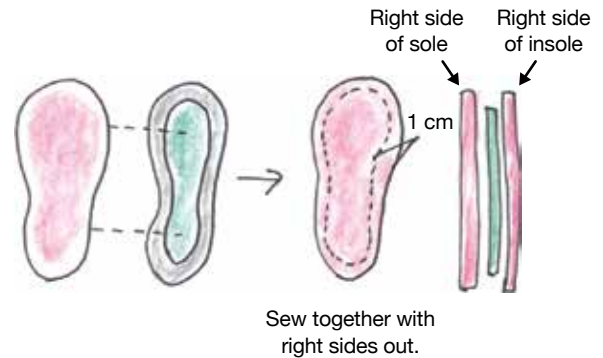
- 1 Affix stabilizer to the wrong side of the insole.

- 2 With right sides out, sew together the sole (felt) and the insole made in step 1 with stitching along the edge and a 1 cm seam allowance.



Sew together with right sides out.

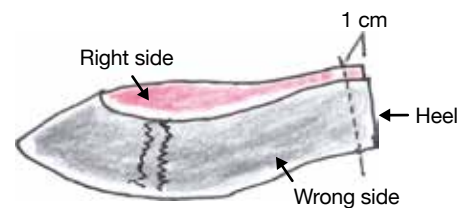
- 3 Sew decorative stitching on the upper.



Select a decorative stitch and sew your custom design.

You can even simply sew zigzag stitching with different thread colors.

- 4 With the right side of the upper in, stitch the heel.



- 5 Pin together the upper and sole at the joining marks, and then sew them together from the right side.



Insert the pins perpendicular to the sewing direction.
